Sunday 8th October, THE BALLAST HOLE BOUNCES BACK - a four mile walk one recently re-opened paths under the two railway lines near Wymington and in the surrounding countryside near the 'ballast hole' pond, a few fields away from Rushden. Meet at 10.30am, outside Wymington Memorial Hall, in Church Lane, Wymington, NN10 9LW, next to St Lawrence's Church, where there is parking on the road.

Sunday 12th November, STANTON WITHOUT THE SEWAGE PIPE: a three mile walk in the new country park and countryside between the Stanton Cross development and the rest of Wellingborough, Meet at 10.30am at the far end of Mill Road, Wellingborough, near its junction with Talbot Road, NN8 1QN,
