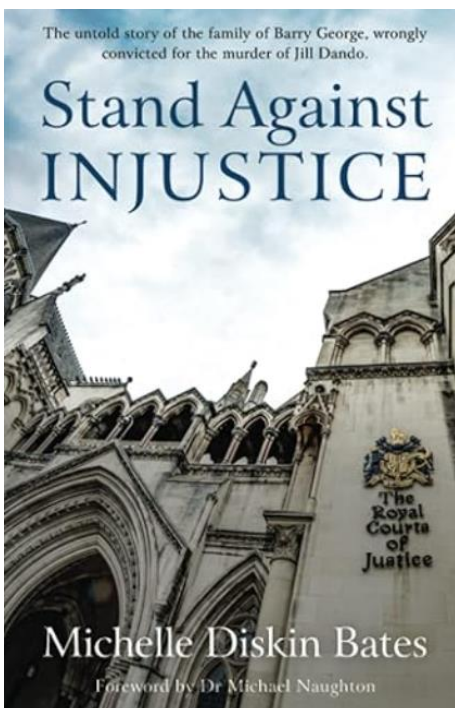

BBC presenter, Jill Dando, was shot dead on her doorstep in Fulham, 25 years ago. Astonishingly, her murder is still unsolved.

The wrongful conviction, and subsequent exoneration of a vulnerable local man, Barry George, thrust his family into a nightmare, and his sister into the hitherto unknown world of legal battles, and media intrusion.

A) First aid for mental health

Hope for Families has recently launched its **First Aid for Mental Health** training for professionals working with families, delivered by our certified First Aid for Mental Health instructor. They have identified an opportunity to support local professionals, churches, schools and other partners by delivering affordable, accessible and practical training in the area of First Aid for Mental Health.
